Instructions for the Examination

1. Any changes to the information provided in the admission guidelines will be announced on our website.

2. Applicant Selection method will be posted using the examination numbers of applicants exempted from the written examination on the university's website at 10:00 on June 26, 2026.
The time when this will be posted on the website is between 10:00 on the day of the announcement until the 17:00 on the seven day from the announcement (including the day of the announcement).

3. Examination Date : August 19, 2026 Spare Date* : August 25, 2026
* Due to unexpected circumstances such as natural disasters, the above examination is postponed on the day that is designated. In the event that the entrance examination cannot be conducted as planned due to a natural disaster, etc., an "Emergency Notice" will be published on the university's website, so be sure to check it.

Please confirm the examination timetable in the "Applicant Selection Method" in the Admission Guidelines.
Those exempt from the written examination are still required to take the oral examination.
4. Examination Location : Nakamozu Campus (The test building will be posted at Nakamozu Gate and Shirasagi Gate.)
5. On the day of the examination, please make certain to bring an entrance examination card (Downloaded and printed from the Internet application site) for the examination and writing utensils.
6. Applicants must enter the examination room 20 minutes prior to the start of the examination.
7. Late arrivals of up to 30 minutes will be admitted after the scheduled start of the examination. For written examinations, you must enter the written examination room before the cutoff time for late arrivals. For oral examinations, you must enter the waiting room for the oral examination before the cutoff time for late arrivals. If you are late, enter the examination room and follow the instructions of the supervisor. The allotted testing time, however, shall not be extended in any cases. In case that the delay is caused by exceptional circumstances mentioned below, late arrival up to 60 minutes and extension of examination time may be permitted. Please contact the main office of the testing site.
 - More than 30 minutes delay by suspension of the public transportation such as train, subway, bus, etc. (which operates according to timetables only) by the accidents.
 - The delay by unexpected accidents, injuries, diseases on the way to the venue.
8. During the examination period, people will not be allowed to leave the room until the test is completed. However, If during the examination a person unavoidably becomes ill or needs to go to the bathroom, they should quietly raise their hand and follow the proctor's instructions.
9. We ask that the examinees please take the seat that matches their examination number and place their entrance examination card on top of the desk.
10. The only items allowed on the desk are: the entrance examination card, a pencil or mechanical pencil, pencil caps, a plastic eraser, a pencil sharpener (excluding electric pencil sharpeners, large pencil sharpeners, or knives), a ruler, a watch (excluding watches with dictionary, calculator or information access functions, watches where it is difficult to determine whether such functions are present, watches that make a sound for each second, kitchen timers and learning timers, or large time pieces) glasses, a handkerchief, eye drops, and tissue paper (only contents that have been removed from the bag or box). Nothing else can be placed on the desk. Electronic devices like cellular phones, smartphones, wearable device (Smartwatch, Smart Glass etc.), tablet terminal, electronic dictionary, IC recorder, Earphone, Electronic devices such as music players must have their alarms turned off and be powered down before entering the examination room. If the watch has an alarm function, deactivate it before turning it off. Otherwise, the alarm may sound even if the watch is turned off. If a person is carrying these items without putting them into their bag during the examination, this could be considered as cheating. However, reading (paper media only) and drinking are permitted in the oral examination waiting room.
11. We ask examinees to not touch the question book or answer sheets until the test proctor instructs them to start the test.
12. We ask that absolutely no answer sheets that are passed out be brought outside the examination room.
13. On the day of the examination, the windows will be open at certain times to ventilate the examination room. Please bring clothing appropriate for the temperature.
14. Smoking is prohibited on the university's ground—indoors and outdoors.
15. The announcement of successful applicants will be posted using the examination numbers of the successful applicants on the university's website at 10:00 on September 4, 2026.

A letter of acceptance and an Enrollment Procedure Guide will be mailed to successful applicants via simplified registered mail (kani-kakitome-yuubin) on the day of announcement. Please note that these can only be mailed to an address in Japan.

16. If cheating is found in the entrance examination, we will take strict action. In addition, if a successful candidate is found to have committed cheating, we will cancel his/her acceptance. Please refer to the university's website for information on the treatment of misconduct during the admission selection process.
