- *If you cannot complete the setup after consulting the manual or FAQ, please visit the support desk listed on the "If You Have Trouble" page of the Information Infrastructure Center website. When you visit, please bring the following items:
 - Your smartphone (or laptop).
 - Personal email address (an email address that can be accessed from your smartphone/laptop, such as Gmail or carrier-specific email).
 - Pre-install the "Google Authenticator" app (or "Google Authentication System") on your smartphone.

*For Internal Advancement Students:

- If you are advancing within the same public university (e.g., from master's to doctoral programs), you do not need to complete the information services setup. Your OMUID and OMU email address will remain the same after your advancement.
- •After your advancement, please check your new student ID number from April onward via the "UNIPA My Page > Academic Information Inquiry" section.
- However, if you are advancing from Osaka Prefecture University or Osaka City University to the Graduate School of Informatics at Osaka Metropolitan University, your OMUID will change after advancement, and you will need to complete the information services setup.

■Important Notes:
