

Application Guidelines for the FY2025 Okamura Award for Female Scientists

1. Outline of the Award

This award was established with funding from donation to the Education Supporters' Association by Chieko Okamura, a graduate of Osaka University of Commerce, which is one of the roots of Osaka Metropolitan University, to promote support for female researchers. Inheriting her wish, Osaka Metropolitan University aims to foster the next generation of excellent female researchers and to contribute* to gender equality in the fields of academic research, by honoring female researchers at the University who have produced creative and ambitious works, to contribute gender equality.

*For the purposes of this award, "contribution to gender equality" includes activities that promote gender equality in academic societies, departments, graduate schools, and local communities, as well as activities in which the applicant serves as a role model (e.g., demonstrating her own efforts in research and work-life balance to younger colleagues).

4. Selection Process and Notification of Selection Results

The selection will be conducted by the Okamura Award Selection Committee, comprising representatives from the Women Researchers Support Office and the Education Supporters' Association. The evaluation will place particular emphasis on the promotion of gender equality, which is the core mission of the award, in addition to recognizing creative and motivated research activities. Applicants will be notified of the results by the end of October.

5. Award Ceremony

The award ceremony is scheduled for Friday afternoon, November 28th, at the Sugimoto Campus. The winners will be announced on the website of the Women Researchers Support Office and other relevant platforms.

6. Prize Details

In addition to the award certificate, an extra prize will be given to the winners.

7. Other matters

Only self-nominations will be accepted.
