His current research interests include learning strategies, language testing, corpus use for pedagogical purposes, and research methodology. He has published articles in journals such as Applied Linguistics, Language Learning, Language Teaching Research, Language Testing, and System. He is the recipient of Best Academic Paper Award from Japan Society of English Language Education in the Year of 2014, the Research Encouragement Award from Japanese Association for English Corpus Studies in the Year of 2016, and the Award for Outstanding Academic Achievement from Language Education and Technology in the Year of 2017. That same year, he was selected as one of the “Top 2% of the World’s Most Influential Researchers” by Stanford University and Elsevier.
